Do you now know how to formulate objectives? Research objectives may be linked with a hypothesis or used as a statement of purpose in a study that does not have a hypothesis. Specific objectives break down the general objective into smaller, logically connected parts that systematically address the various aspects of the problem. In general, research objectives describe what we expect to achieve by a project. Your specific objectives should specify exactly what you will do in each phase of your study, how, where, when and for what purpose. Leadership has many aspects such as employee motivation, ethical behaviour, strategic planning, change management etc. Specific objectives are detailed objectives that describe what will be researched during the study, whereas the general objective is a much broader statement about what the study aims to achieve overall. In the next study session, we will move on to teach you about research strategies and alternative study designs that you may choose to conduct for a small-scale research project in your community. In the above examples the intent of the research is largely descriptive. Search Formulating Research Aims and Objectives Formulating research aim and objectives in an appropriate manner is one of the most important aspects of your thesis. Your objectives should be stated using action verbs that are specific enough to be measured, for example: to compare, to calculate, to assess, to determine, to verify, to calculate, to describe, to explain, etc. Conducting interviews with 20 sample group members and collecting primary data through 2 focus groups when only three months left until submission of your dissertation can be very difficult, if not impossible. Without clearly written research objectives, you might be confused about the limits of the study, what data should be collected, or how to conduct the research. Accordingly, timeframe available need to be taken into account when formulating research aims and objectives and selecting specific research methods. These observations might prompt researchers to formulate hypotheses which could be tested in another piece of research. Research objectives should be closely related to the statement of the problem and summarise what you hope will be achieved by the study. As a rule of thumb, there would be one research aim and several research objectives to facilitate the achievement of this aim. Objectives can be general or specific. Choosing the topic too broadly.
